

THE PERFECT PLAYOFF PLAN

16 Team National Championship Playoff

The Goal to crown an [Undisputed National Champion](#) for Major College Football by adopting the Perfect Playoff Plan fulfills the desire of the NCAA's stake holders including the Athletes, Students, Alumni, School Administration and Fans utilizing the [S.A.F.E. Philosophy](#) that puts students and academics first with fair and equal treatment for every Conference and School.

Reorganize the **Division 1A Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS)** returning responsibility for the Division, its Bowl season and Championship Playoff to the NCAA and its member Schools. Taking back control from the Conferences and the College Football Playoff (CFP) to make sure that a [S.A.F.E. Philosophy](#) is applied to a New 90 Team football only [Major College Football Division](#) (MCFD) putting the Student and Academics first, while being Fair to every Football Program establishing Equality among the Conferences.

Reform the FBS to include the 64 **Power 5** teams, **Notre Dame** and the [Top 25 Group of Five](#) teams to make a new 90 Team football only Major College Football Division (MCFD). Applying both the [No Patsy Rule](#) for an 11 game Regular Season and [No Cupcake Rule](#) that raises all teams to the same Equal Status in the new Major College Football Division that uses the principles of the [S.A.F.E. Philosophy](#) to return College Football to its original status as an Amateur Sport that serves its University Community.

Resturcture the FBS into a new football only Major College Football Division (MCFD) made up of 10 Conferences with 9 teams based on the Power 5 Conference Divisions where every team plays the other 8 Conference members. Also replacing the 4 team [Failed CFP](#) with a 16 Team [National Championship Playoff Series](#) made up of the 10 Conference Champions and the 6 Second Place Teams with the most wins in a 4 Round Playoff ending the Saturday after January 4th of the following year. A Plan that reduces the excessive number of Teams (130), Regular Season games (12), Season weeks (14), the extra Conference Championship Games (10) and Post Season Bowls (40). Proving that less is best with 90 Teams playing an 11 game Regular Season over 12 weeks ending with a 4 round 16 Team Playoff and a reduced [27 Bowl Post Season](#) for teams with a 6 - 5 or better season records.

And Realign the 10 Conferences based on the 9 Power 5 Divisions and taking out enough teams from the Power 5 Conferences to make an equal strength 10th Conference. Next dividing the 25 Group of 5 teams among these 10 Conferences based on regional alignment to make them of equal status, size and strength of programs. The Perfect Plan also solves the Playoff selection dilemma by automatically including the 10 Conference Champions and the 6 second place teams with the most wins during the Regular Season for the 16 team National Championship Playoff.
